#### Skiing and Snowboarding



There are many ski and snowboard resorts in and around Vaud, each offering a range of slopes for every level. The main resorts are accessible by public transportation. With a "Free Pass," which is similar to a credit card, skiers and snowboarders have access to all Vaud Alps resorts. Ski days can be tracked and paid for online without queuing.

#### Attractions

The [Château de Chillon](#) is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Switzerland. The Alps provide a dramatic backdrop to this medieval island castle on Lake Geneva. Located in Vevytau, Vaud, the castle is over 1000 years old, and has inspired poets, writers, and artists.

The [Olympic Museum](#), which is located in Lausanne, Vaud, houses the largest collection of Olympic Games artifacts in the world. On the banks of Lake Geneva, the museum is surrounded by Olympic Park. The International Olympics Committee headquarters are also located in Lausanne.

[Queen: The Studio Experience](#) is a museum dedicated to Freddy Mercury and his band, who recorded at Mountain Studios in Montreux. The museum includes memorabilia and a sound studio where visitors can listen to Queen tracks while sitting in a reproduction of the studio at which they were recorded.

#### Events

The [Montreux Jazz Festival](#) is held yearly in July and is the second largest of its kind in the world. Founded in 1967, the festival originally featured only jazz artists. For many years now, however, international musicians and artists of every genre perform at the festival.

The [Montreux Christmas Market](#) is a traditional holiday celebration that takes place in the marketplace and along the lake. The market runs yearly from late November through December 24. Jewelry, clothing, arts and crafts, and food and mulled wine are sold from 150 chalets and stalls.

The town of Vevey celebrates Saint Martin every year on the second Tuesday in November. The [Saint Martin Fair](#) has been held in the Vevey marketplace on the lake for more than 500 years! Historically, residents were allowed to sell their wares without being taxed. The street fair includes entertainment, food, a procession of farm animals, and stalls where locals still sell their products.
